1. God, Do You Care About Me?

God cares by revealing himself:

through revelation- the Bible

through the witness of your heart

2. God, Do You Hear Me?

Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

2. God, Do You Hear Me?

If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him? Matt
7:11

3. God, Do You Get Me?

For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted. Heb 2:18

Jesus ...was in all points tempted like as we are... Heb. 4:15

4. God, Do You Understand How I Feel?

For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

Heb. 4:15

4. God, Do You Understand How I Feel?

The phrase

“touched with the feeling”

is the Greek word

Sympatheo

or

5. God, Am I Normal?

For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly,

Romans 12:3

6. God, Who Am I?

You are either

“In the flesh” or “in the Spirit”

So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you.

Romans 8:8-9

7. God, How Will I Then Behave?

Behavior flows from identity.

Your behavior agrees with your identity.

For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

Eph. 5:8
